TEACHING ASSISTANT APPLICATION:

Are you thinking about a career in teaching? Want to learn more about professional theater production? This may be the position for you! This *paid* program is open to teens and young adults aged 16-23 with prior camp experience, an interest in theater and a passion for teaching in the arts. Gain valuable work experience, work directly with foolsFURY Theater members and boost any resume or college application, all while doing what you love.

Who's eligible: Any responsible young adult aged 16-23 with prior camp experience, either at Swivel Arts or another camp.

- Characters! Voiceover for Cartoons & Video Games w/Deborah Eliezer (K-5)/ Jun 28-Jul 2
- My Voice, My Story: Hip-Hop, Music & Mural Making (K-5)/ Jul 26-Aug 6
- From the Page to the Stage: Japanese Folktale (K-5)/ Aug 9-13
- Caribbean Caravan: African-Haitian Dance, Drama & Giant Puppets (K-5)/ Aug 16-20
- The Reel You: Acting for the Camera (K-5)/ Aug 23-27

Some responsibilities include:

- developing and leading lunchtime activities
- leading a specific aspect of performance production (e.g. costumes, choreography, sets/props, aftercare, playground field trip, etc)
- working closely with other interns and staff
- assistant directing the performance

Weekly Schedule: TA's are expected to attend all days (Mon-Fri) of the session. Punctuality is important! Mondays, TA's arrive at 8am for an orientation and staff meeting. All other days interns arrive at 8:30 am and stay until 3:30 pm. Bring a bag lunch everyday, and wear loose-fitting clothes.

- TA's will be expected to work 20 hrs/wk.
- TA's must be available for a minimum of 2 sessions, preference given to those who can do 4 sessions or more
- All TA's must attend a mandatory teacher training prior to camp and weekly meetings during camp.

Compensation: TA's will receive a stipend of \$100-\$400 for the summer, depending on experience (at Camp Director's discretion).
